

# GRANITE FIRE PIT

## INSTRUCTIONS / MATERIALS

ENCORE  STONE  
P R O D U C T S



48" Outside Diameter

36" Inside Diameter

12.5" High

147 Stones in Kit (7 extra)

14 Stones per row.

10 Rows High (1.25" per row)

### MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Shovel
- Level
- Tape Measure
- Paver Base
- High Heat Silicone
- Gloves
- Crushed Granite Rock
- Spray Paint
- Chalk
- Tamper
- Silicone Gun
- Rubber Mallet

### ASSEMBLY STEPS

1



Select location for your fire pit, if using lawn/dirt location mark a 48" circle on surface and dig 2" down. Use level to ensure your base is even. If using existing patio surface, you can mark the circle with chalk (Not for use under covered patios or under trees). Now skip to step #3.

2



Put approx 2" of paver base into your circle - this **MUST** be tamped level before laying Encore Stones.

Select 14 stones you will use for your top row and set them to the side.\* Then take 14 more stones and lay them on top of (the outer edge) of paver base- rough side facing up. Stones will have small gaps between joints when laid; which allows airflow for healthy fires.

Once the first row is laid, apply a bead of high heat silicone to middle of stones and lay second row on top of first row (always rough side facing up), staggering joints as shown in picture above.

Repeat step #4 for rows 3-10, using the first 14 pieces you set aside for row #10 (Don't forget- install rough side up). Stop every 2 rows and use rubber mallet to tap any pieces that may have shifted before silicone fully cures.

Once Fire Pit is built, add bags of crushed granite rock to center and installation is complete. Before using- check silicone tube for exact cure time.

*\*Rough side up is recommended for top row*

Encore Stone Fire Pits are sold for outdoor use only. For use by adults only.- keep children and pets at safe distance
